Fuzzy and cuddly, and not to mention "stylish" and "QUICK"!

(... did I mention QUICK?)

YARN

1—3 ounce ball of Wool-ease worsted weight yarn

2—1 3/4 ounce balls of Lion Brand Fun Fur

(just about any comparable worsted weight wool, and fabulous glitz or eyelash yarn can be substi-

tuted, as gauge is not that important here. HOWEVER, pay mind to the yardage!) NEEDLES

Set of US#13 straights OR circulars

OTHER

Large eye darning needle Measuring tape

LEGEND

CO-cast on

k-knit

p—purl

inc1—increase one by knitting and purling into the same stitch

k2tog—knit 2 stitches together

st-stitch sts-stitches

Let's start!



Using both yarns held together as one, CO 2 sts Knit one row

ROW1—inc1, k across (make these increases loose so they do not pull)

ROW2—k

Repeat Rows 1—2 until you have 14 sts on the needle Knit in garter stitch until the total piece (measure from point) measures 54 inches. Begin decreases. Length is totally up to you, and dependant on the amount of yarn.

ROW1—k to the last 2 sts, k2tog ROW2—k

Repeat Rows 1—2 until there are 2 sts left

ROW1—knit

ROW2—k2tog

Finish and sew in all ends neatly.
